Helping hospices to provide the best delirium care

Delirium causes confusion and difficulty thinking. It may affect people with serious illness and be distressing for the patient and those close to them.

St Leonard's Hospice is taking part in a study which aims to help us provide the best delirium detection, prevention, and care.

An authorised Delirium study researcher (bound by confidentiality) will be working with our team. She is approved to access confidential patient records of those admitted to our unit between 7th June 2022 and 19th September 2022. She will record information about delirium and the delirium care received. The information collected **will not** contain anything that would allow identification of the patient in any way.
