

Referral criteria for St Leonard's Hospice's Wellbeing and Outreach services

The following information provides guidance on which people are likely to benefit from referral to St Leonard's Hospice's Wellbeing and Outreach team.

Our Wellbeing & Outreach team can support with practical issues, emotional support, finance and benefits, carer support, spiritual care, complementary therapy, anticipatory grief and pre-bereavement, Wills and Lasting Power of Attorney, and Advance Care Planning.

General criteria

- Adult aged 18 or over.
- Diagnosis of life-limiting condition (progressive incurable disease).
- Carer or loved one of someone with a life-limiting condition.
- Person being referred is registered with a GP practice in the Hospice catchment area.

Unsuitable referrals

Examples of people who are **not** suitable for Wellbeing and Outreach services:

- Children (under 18).
- People who require support with complex symptom management and are **not** under the care of the community palliative care team.
- People with complex mental health problems who are **not** also supported by mental health services.
